2. The management of Frank W. Ballou Senior High School Alumni contributions, events and community service programs for the purpose of supporting existing Frank W. Ballou Senior High School Students, Faculty and Administration in that particular order. The organization and delivery of programs for school and community improvement to support and facilitate concerns of the Frank W. Ballou Sr. High School Alumni

I

The name of this organization is the Frank W. Ballou Senior High School Alumni Association.

II

- A. This organization is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.
- B. The Specific purposes for which this corporation is organized include, but are not limited to:
 3. and/or the Frank W. Ballou Senior High School and/or the Frank W. Ballou Senior High School Parent Teacher Student Association (PTSA) [or whatever name it may have at the time];
 4. the promotion and preservation of any Frank W. Ballou Senior High School historic, educational, ecological, recreational, agricultural, scenic or other concerns.

- A. The corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of said Code, or the corresponding provisions of any future statute of the United States.
- C. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; nor shall the corporation participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, any assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to a governmental entity described in Section 170(b)(1) (A)(v) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and which is qualified to receive "qualified conservation contributions" within the meaning of Section 170(h) of said Code, or the corresponding provisions of any future statute of the United States.
- C. In the event of a liquidation of this corporation, all corporate assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the superior court for the county in


